## Waiver of Liability Release

Participants are required to sign the following release. I assume all risks and hazards incidental to such participation and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the City of Lakewood, City of Lakewood Parks and Recreation Department, Pierce County Parks and Recreation, staff, coaches and volunteers for any claim arising from injury to my/our child. Furthermore, in case of any emergency and I should require medical attention, I give permission for a City of Lakewood representative, or the representative's designee, to secure the emergency medical attention required. Any direction to the contrary should be noted on the backside of this form and signed. I agree that pictures taken during program hours may be used for future promotional purposes.

## Adult Co-Ed Soccer League Rules

1. Active professional players are not allowed to play in this league.
2. Final rosters are due before the teams spots will be secured for the league. No rosters will be accepted after the first game of league play.
3. Three females must be on the field at all times (not to include the goalkeeper who may be male or female). If there are not enough females to start the game within five minutes of the scheduled start time then the team with not enough females will have to forfeit.
4. No slidetackling. An indirect free kick will be awarded to the opponent.
5. Games will consist of two 40-minute halves with a 5-minute break between.
6. Shin guards covered by socks are required.
7. Team members must wear shirts of a matching color. Goalkeepers' shirts must be a different color from the field players'.
8. No jewelry or metal cleats.
9. *Off-side* will be called.
10. Major fouls will result in a direct kick with all members of the aggressor's team at least 10 yards from the ball. Technical fouls will result in an indirect kick.
11. At the referee's discretion, if a male player is too aggressive against a female player, an indirect kick will be awarded against the aggressor's team.
12. Violence and abuse, both physical and verbal, will not be tolerated. Teams will be held responsible for the actions of their players, coaches and fans. Players will be dismissed from league play if necessary to maintain a calm, safe and fun playing atmosphere.
13. Any player ejected from a game by the referee will be issued a one-game suspension that will be applied to the following scheduled game.
14. The winning team shall report the score by calling 253.983.7827 by the end of business (5pm) the Monday following a game.
15. Players may only be listed on one team's roster and can only play for that team throughout the season.
16. Game schedules will be set by the Recreation Coordinator and distributed to the coaches at the mandatory coaches meeting, any rescheduling done after the first game of league play will result in a \$25.00 fine for the team requesting the reschedule.
17. End-of-season tournament champion earns \$100 credit toward the following league's registration fee.
