REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS  
PROFESSIONAL SURVEYING, ENGINEERING, ARCHITECTURE,  
PLANNING, AND RELATED SERVICES ROSTER

City of Lakewood (City) is requesting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from firms qualified and interested in providing professional surveying, engineering, architecture, planning, and related services for various transportation, stormwater, sanitary sewer, parks, and site development projects for 2010 and 2011. Statement of Qualifications submitted Fiscal Year 2010 will remain on the roster until January 31, 2012.

The City of Lakewood expects to need assistance in the following categories:

- Surveying
- Roadway & Storm Drainage Design and Plan, Specification, and Engineer's Estimate (PS&E) Development
- Computer-Aided Drafting (CAD)
- Environmental Services (e.g. SEPA/EIS, NEPA, Wetlands, Habitat, Permitting)
- Geotechnical Services
- Right-of-Way Services
- Landscape Design and PS&E Development
- Irrigation Design and PS&E Development
- Park Design and PS&E Development (including shorelines)
- Construction Management
- Traffic Studies and Transportation Planning
- Traffic Signal Design and Coordination
- Stormwater Management
- Structural Engineering Services (e.g. building design review; retaining wall, pole foundations, and park shelter foundation design)
- Planning (e.g. comprehensive planning, development regulations/zoning ordinance, critical areas)
- Architecture (small parks and maintenance facilities)
- Materials Testing
- Arborist
- Utility Rates /Financial Economic Analysis

Submittals must include a letter of interest listing which categories the firm wishes to be considered for. The City may opt to utilize a single firm for multiple project phases. The SOQs will be evaluated by a committee comprised of City staff. Consultants will be evaluated on the basis of past experience and performance (include references), qualifications of staff, and project management approach. Consultants selected for grant-

funded projects must demonstrate experience with projects awarded grant dollars from Federal Highway Administration, Washington State, and/or Housing and Urban Development. Final selection from the City's Professional Services Roster will be based on the evaluation of SOQs unless it is deemed necessary by the committee to request a proposal and/or conduct interviews. Placement on the City's Professional Services Roster does not guarantee award of contract.

The City encourages disadvantaged, minority, and women-owned consulting firms to respond.

The Consultant shall comply with the regulations relative to nondiscrimination in the same manner as in Federal-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation, Title 49, CFR, Part 21, as they may be amended from time to time. The Consultant shall comply with the American Disabilities Act of 1992, as amended.
