

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **Can I build with a group?**

Yes, we have added a group category. A group is two or more people. For example an entire class can participate, a Boy Scout troop, or any group of friends.

### **When is the registration deadline?**

The registration deadline is November 10<sup>th</sup>.

**What size platforms can I use?** Participants can use any size platform, as long as it is no larger than 24" by 24". The important thing is that the platform is sturdy so that when it is moved by staff, it stays in one piece.

### **Where can I get a platform?**

There are two sizes of free, plywood platforms available. They are 24"x24" (recommended for groups) or 10"x10". You can choose the size. You can use your own plywood base or pick one up at Lakewood City Hall, 6000 Main street SW, 98499 between 8:30am-5:00pm Mon-Fri. You can also pick up a base at the Tacoma Children's Museum. If a school or organization is interested, an entire stack of platforms can be delivered.

### **Why are you collecting lego donations and how will they be distributed?**

We are collecting used legos so that low-income children who do not have legos can also participate in the contest. The City of Lakewood will distribute the legos to our Healthy Start after school programs for children to build creations during that program.

### **When can I drop off my creation?**

Creations can be dropped off at Lakewood City Hall any time before November 30, by 5:00 pm. Please call Sally on the number below to let her know to expect you.
