



January - December 2014-2016









Analysis:




Lakewood PD Gang Related Arrests 2015- 2016YTD




Analysis:

Society Crimes by Month 2014-2015-2016







Lakewood Police Department Total Traffic Stops 2015-2016YTD



Highlights for July 2016

- Case 1618702203 Shots fired at the Sun Pacific Energy Station at Steilacoom and Phillips. License plate was obtained, officers found the associated vehicle, surveillance tape was viewed and arrests were made. No injuries.
- Case 1618800639 Attempted carjacking of a DOC officer at 11919 Pacific HWY. DOC officer drew his firearm and the suspect ran. Suspect stole an idling vehicle at a local car lot and fled. Stolen vehicle was later found in Tacoma. Suspect is at large and unidentified.
- Case 1620200336 Shooting investigation at the Western Inn. Victim was shot following a confrontation. That person was able to return fire and upon police arrival, all parties had fled. Victim went to the ER with a gunshot wound to the back. One suspect still at large.
- Aggravated Assaults increased from July 2015 and year to date, Aggravated Assaults are up 29.23% while Crimes Against Persons are overall down 14.95%.
- Burglaries were up from July 2015 and year to date are up 14%.
- Auto thefts continue to be a problem with 42 in July (up 42.14% YTD). The normal monthly range in Lakewood is 19-26 MVT.
- Lakewood apartments had some notable Serious Call For Service standouts in Legacy Apartments (former Sage Terrace) with 10 SCFS, Village at Seeley Lake with 10 SCFS and most notably, McChord Tudor Haus (25 units) with 9 SCFS. What makes them notable is that they had 9 SCFS compared to Village at Seeley Lake's 10 SCFS and 520 units.
- Standout in Mobile Home Parks (MHP) was Jamestown Estates MHP on 146th St with 4 SCFS. Jamestown Estates leads SCFS YTD with 12 edging out Karwan Village with 11.
- Lakewood Bars were somewhat quiet with only 3 total SCFS spread out across 3 different bars.
- The Lakewood Motels experienced 9 SCFS with 4 of those at the Western Inn including a shooting described above. Golden Lion was red tagged (uninhabitable on 20 July 2016)
